

## STEM Outreach

- Mentis currently employs 13 paid high school and college students through its Intern Program.
- Interns gain hands-on experience shadowing Mentis staff.
- Training in machining, computer repair, general office duties, composite fabrication, machine preventative maintenance, general shop duties, and materials testing.
- Interns have worked on fabrication of prosthetic sockets, advanced nosecone materials, and materials analysis.
- Interns receive focused weekly physics & engineering lessons from engineers via interactive classes and demonstrations.
- Mentis engineers assist with personal development plans for post-high school preparation.
